



## Spring Quarter Job Announcement

The UC Davis Arboretum has three positions available for students interested in helping to map the Arboretum's plant collections starting this spring and continuing through summer. Each position is available for a flexible schedule of 10-20 hours per week for spring quarter, and pays \$10/hour.

The Arboretum is in the process of converting our existing plant collections maps into ESRI's ArcGIS format, and will be using Global Positioning System (GPS) technology to accurately map the locations of plants and amenities. We are looking for students who can use the existing collection maps to identify plant specimens, and then use GPS to record their locations and taxonomic information.

Applicants should have enough experience with plant identification to tell a *Ceanothus* from a *Quercus*, but are not expected to have extensive plant knowledge. Applicants should also be comfortable using new technology, but are not expected to have GPS experience. All training will be provided.
